**Notification of Upcoming Heavy Vehicle Movement – Power Transformer Delivery – Bulabul Battery Energy Storage System (SSD 27014706)**

AMPYR Australia is writing to advise you of an upcoming heavy vehicle delivery to the Bulabul Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project site, located on Twelve Mile Road, Wuuluman.

The oversize and overmass (OSOM) deliveries for the project are now nearing completion. Two prefabricated switch room buildings and one operational and maintenance building have already been successfully delivered to site. The final and largest movement, the main power transformer, is still to come, and this notification relates to that delivery. This delivery is now confirmed to arrive on site around midday (lunch time) on Tuesday 15 September 2026. Timings remain subject to change, and we will notify you if this occurs.

**Transformer delivery**

The project's main power transformer will be transported from the Port of Adelaide, SA to the Bulabul Battery site. It is a substantially larger load, classified as a high-risk OSOM movement. The laden combination measures approximately 71 metres long, 4.5 metres wide and 5.6 metres high, with a total mass of about 345 tonnes. Given its size, this delivery will also travel under Police escort. Residents may notice the convoy moving more slowly and escort vehicles holding traffic for longer periods to allow safe passage.

**What this means for you**

- You may see delivery vehicles and their escorts travelling along local roads during the delivery period. The final approach to site is via Dubbo, along the Mitchell Highway, onto Goolma Road and then Twelve Mile Road.
- Escort vehicles may briefly slow or hold traffic to allow the load to pass safely
- No road closures are currently planned; minor, short-term delays may occur
