Overview

The Investment Analyst supports AMPYR Australia's capital agenda across capital raising (equity and debt), project finance transactions, and investment analysis, working closely with the Capital team to progress transactions from origination through to completion.

The role supports capital execution with transaction management, due diligence Q&A, financial modelling, and the preparation of materials for Investment Committees and external financiers. It plays an active role in day-to-day stakeholder engagement across live transactions.

The role works internally across AMPYR Australia teams including Development, Customer, Technical, Grid, Legal, and Construction. Externally it engages with both current and prospective investors and lenders, advisers, and project counterparties.
