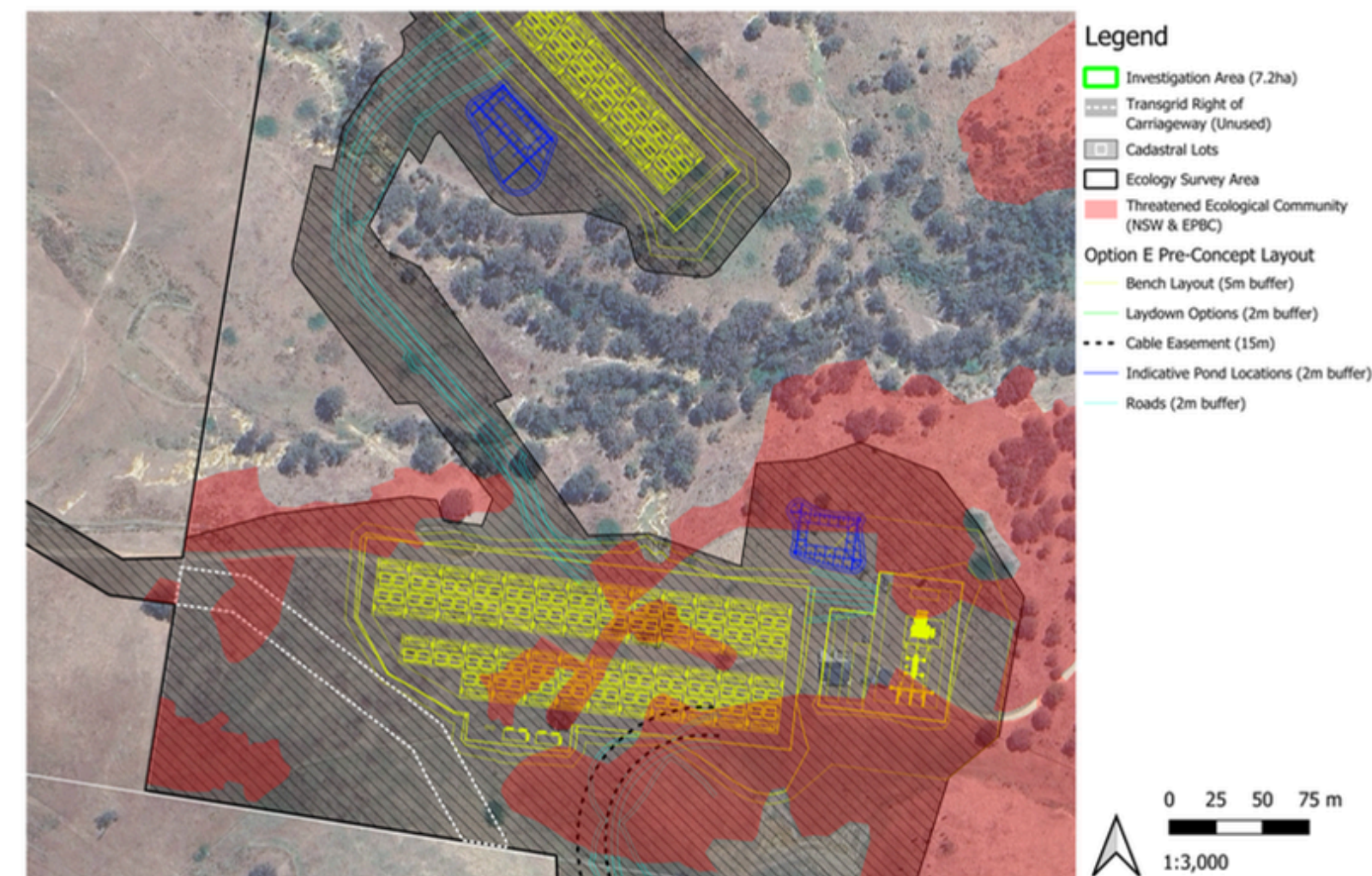

Swallow Tail Battery - Disturbance Footprint, Option E Layout, TEC Mapping



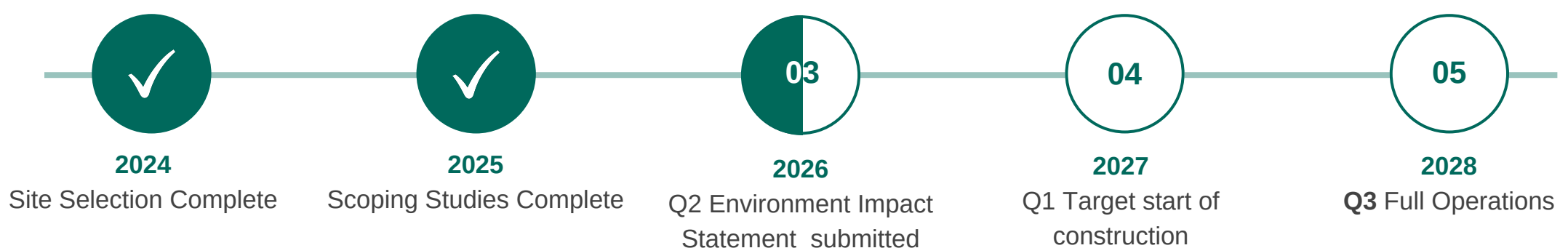
Planning Status

Throughout 2025, the project progressed planning studies including environmental, visual, noise and traffic assessments. Following completion of these studies, the project will be submitting a Development Application to the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure, with an outcome expected in late 2026.

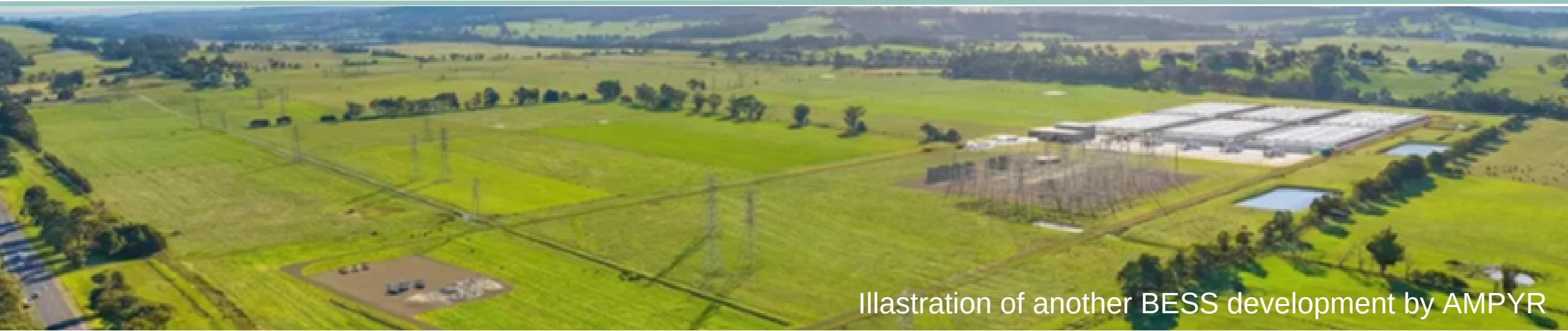
