ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Wimpole Battery is a proposed 375 MW / 1,500 MWh battery by AMPYR Australia, on cleared low-value farm land north of the Princes Highway, Bunyip North.

AMPYR has committed to provide \$250 per MWh every year in community benefit funding, equating to over **\$370,000 of funding per annum**, for the life of the project.
