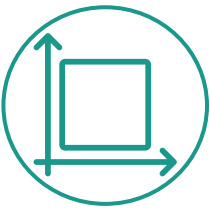

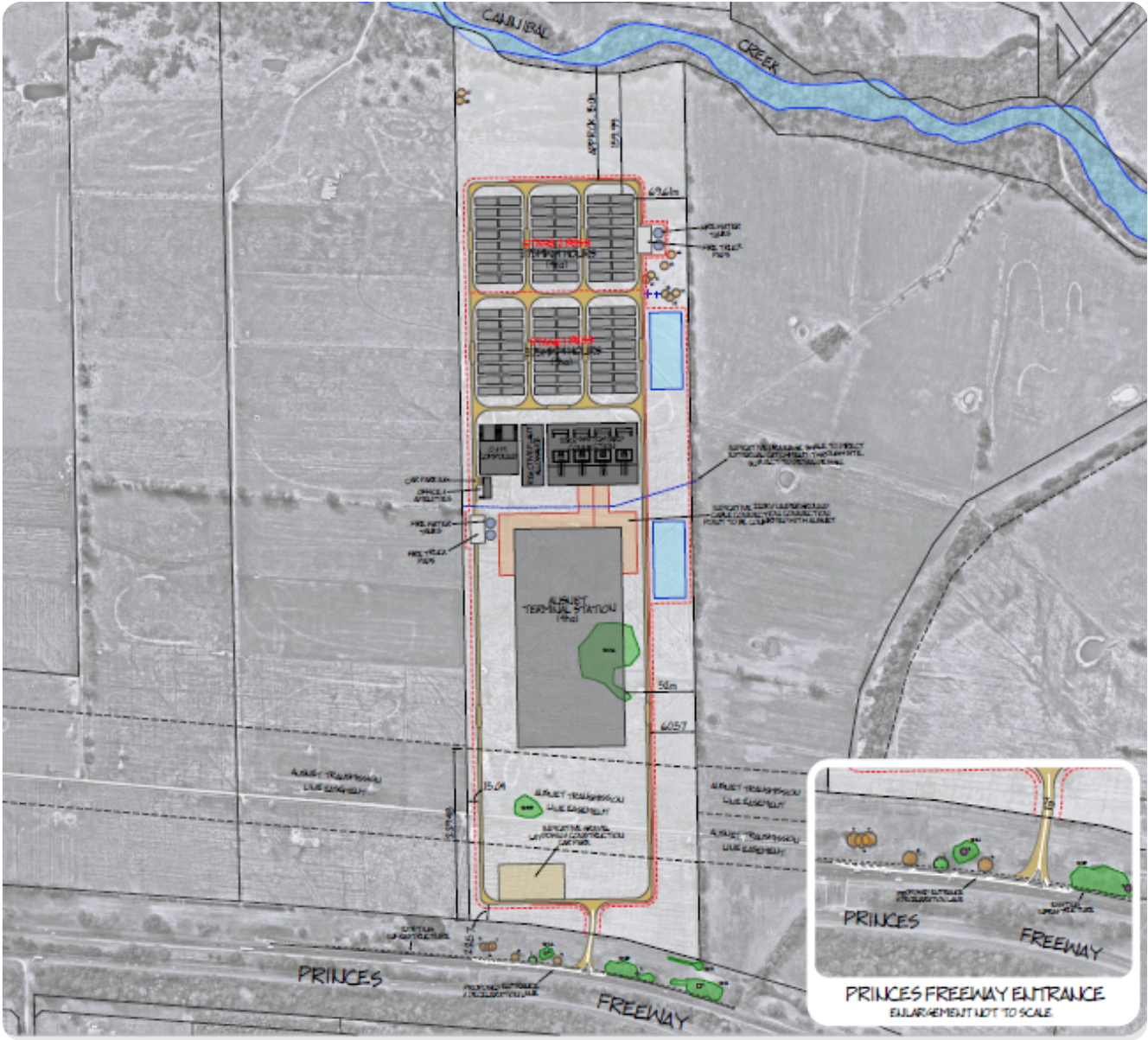

Planning Status

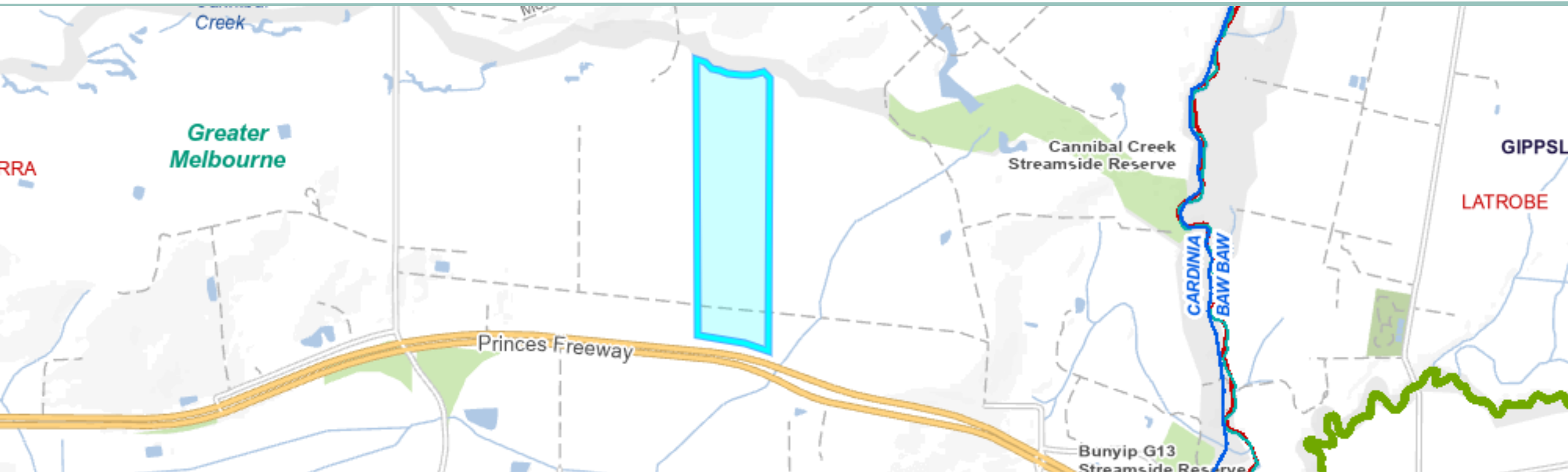
Following the completion of technical studies including noise, visual and traffic assessments in early 2026, AMPYR submitted a planning permit application to the Minister for Planning. The application will be assessed under Victoria's Planning and Environment Act 1987 and follow the Department of Transport and Planning's Development Facilitation Program (DFP) process, with an outcome expected between October 2026 to March 2027

Community Benefits

AMPYR is committed to delivering real and lasting benefits to local Bunyip organisations and initiatives that strengthen community wellbeing and invest in the causes that matter most to residents. In 2025 we established the first \$40,000 round of the Wimpole Battery Community Benefit Fund (CBF), where selected organisations were awarded up to \$5,000 each. Applications for the 2026 round will be opening in the coming months. Application guidelines and eligibility criteria can be found at ampyr.com.au

In addition to the annual CBF, AMPYR has committed to providing \$250 per MWh every year in community benefit funding, equating to over \$370,000 of funding per annum, for the life of the project. This pool of funding has been set aside to benefit a multitude of ventures, including direct energy rebates for Bunyip North residents, scholarships, training and education in the project construction phase, biodiversity and conservation for the region and more.

AMPYR is now welcoming Expressions of Interest (EOI) to join the Wimpole Battery **Community Reference Group** – an advisory group that will provide guidance during development and construction and help inform how the project shares benefits locally into the future.
