

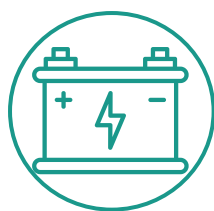


ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY

About the Project

AMPYR is developing the Wimpole Battery, a utility-scale energy storage project located north of Bunyip. The project avoids high value agricultural land and will deliver over \$7million in direct community benefits to the Cardinia region.

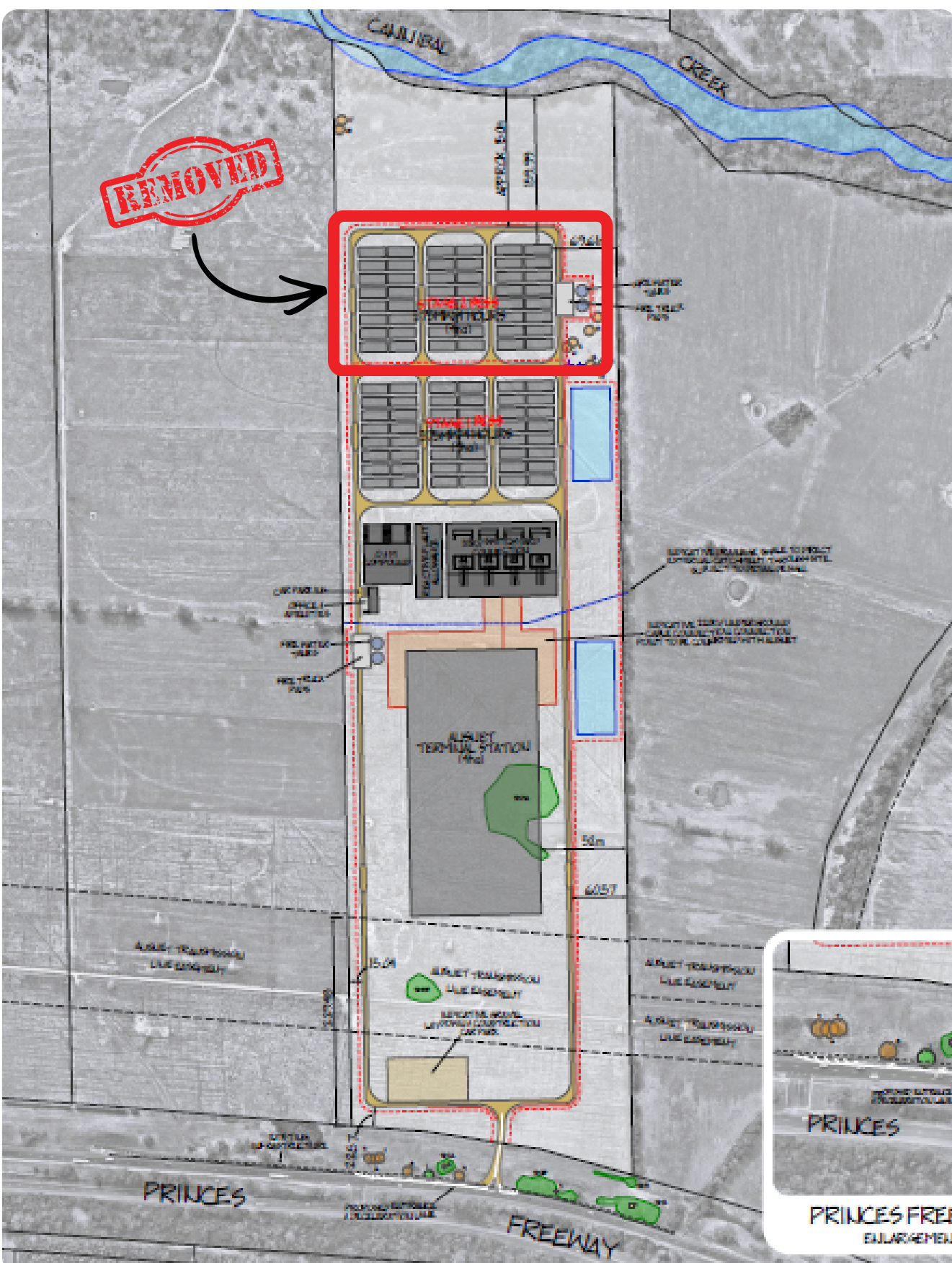

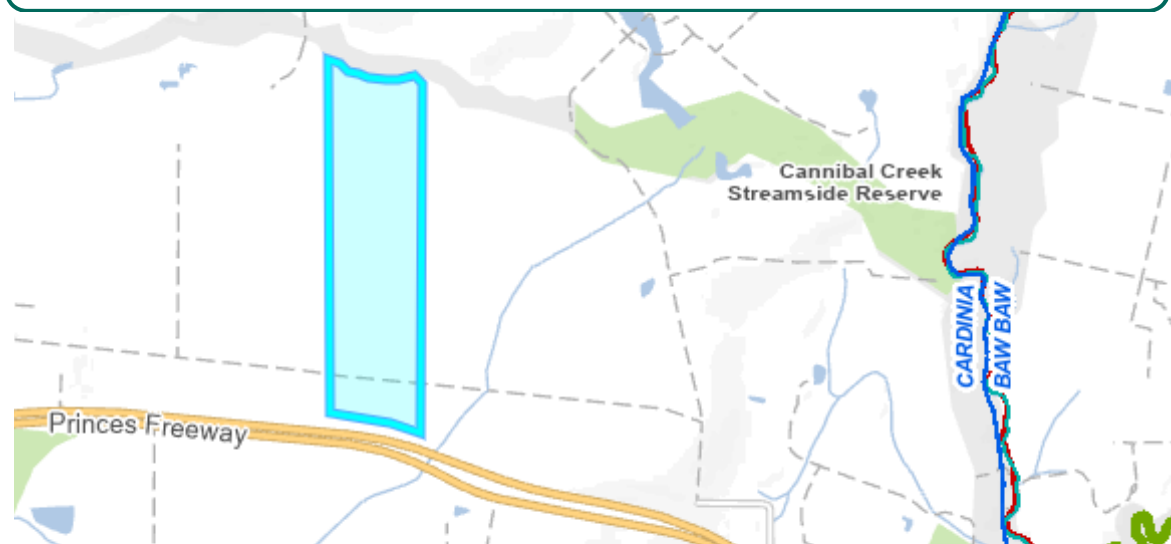


Planning Status

In early 2026, technical studies covering noise, visual and traffic impacts were completed for the Wimpole Battery, and a planning permit application was submitted to the Minister for Planning. The application is being assessed under Victoria's Planning and Environment Act 1987 through the Department of Transport and Planning's Development Facilitation Program, with an outcome expected between October 2026 and March 2027.

Design Update

To ensure that the ultimate project is designed to the local context, responds to community feedback and considers the findings of preliminary studies, the Wimpole Battery has been revised to be a smaller, single-stage project. Technical studies are currently being updated to reflect this change, and will be made available for review upon finalisation.

Community Benefits

AMPYR is committed to delivering real, lasting benefits to the Bunyip community — investing in the causes that matter most to residents over the life of the battery. Our community benefit commitments total more than **\$7 million** over 20 years, and will include direct payments to neighbours, energy bill relief, and locally directed funding informed by the community.

Direct benefits to neighbours

- Over **\$2.5million** in benefits shared with near neighbours.
- Over **\$700,000** of additional benefits shared with Bunyip North residents through an annual energy affordability program

Local infrastructure and environment

- \$500,000** to the Bunyip Recreation Reserve for energy saving improvements.
- \$500,000** to the local Country Fire Authority to improve volunteer brigade response and fund training.
- \$500,000** to support local conservation and wildlife projects.

Community-directed funding

- \$1,614,000** over 20 years for a local community funding for Bunyip and surrounds
- \$500,000** in regional community funding
- \$120,000** in grants over three years during project development

Community Benefit Fund

The Wimpole battery Community Benefit Fund opens on **1 September 2026** and will provide grants to support local projects, events, and initiatives across Bunyip and surrounds, helping deliver a lasting benefit to the community.

Grants can support all sorts of activities, from community facilities and local events to environmental projects, education, and health and wellbeing. Not-for-profit organisations, schools and local community groups are all welcome to apply, along with businesses running a project on a not-for-profit basis that benefits the community. Projects just need to be located in, or provide services to, communities near the project.
